Quay Arts

Memorial tree

A stone cairn & plaque mark the site of a Cherry tree planted by the Japanese Ambassador in 1974, since replaced, after it's death, with a Hornbeam (left of the cairn).

4 Shide Hill House Observatory

Now a private residence, 27 Blackwater Road is built on the site of Milne's observatory, the original world headquarters for earthquake seismology!

The original date stone still exists, situated within the wall of an upper room.
