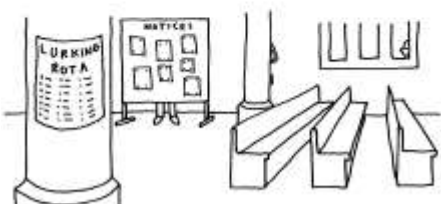

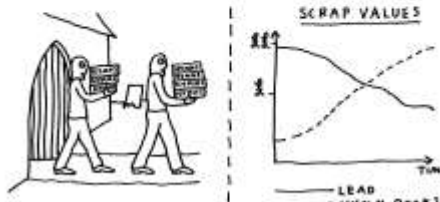
LOCK IT
