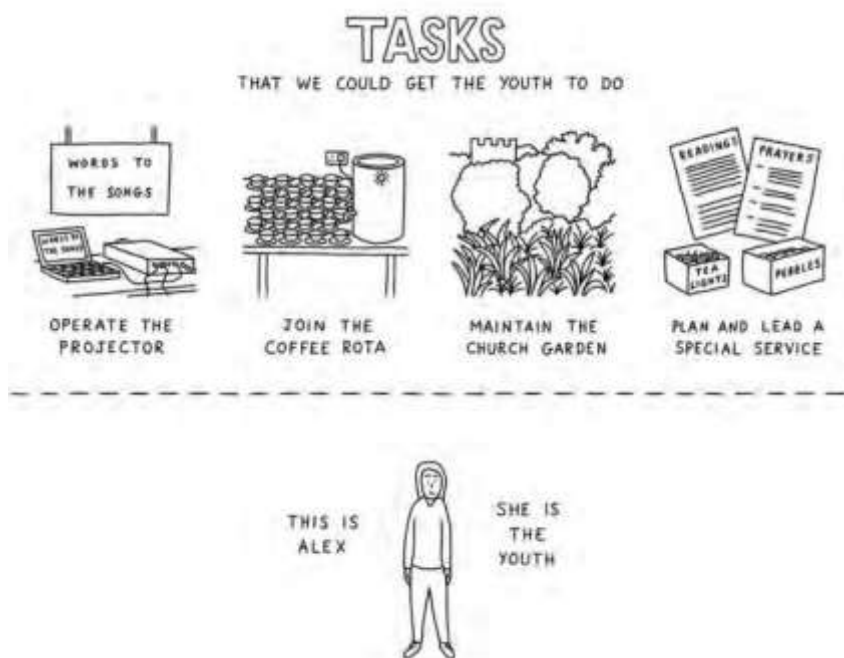

It is observed on the first two days of Tishrei, the seventh month of the Hebrew calendar and is described in the Torah as (Yom Teru'ah, a day of sounding [the Shofar]). Rosh Hashana begins at sundown 20th.
