## Salvation Army Winter Shelter 2017/18



As Ian explained last Sunday, the PCC has responded unanimously to support the following request from the Salvation Army here in Newport. This will involve using the Christian Centre on Thursday evenings during the 6 month winter period.

We would appreciate volunteers to act **as 'keyholders' on these evenings as well as anyone willing to get alongside the homeless in our community. Speak to Ian if you'd like to help.**

*"The Salvation Army have decided to operate a winter shelter during the winter months this year to meet the increasing need and challenges posed on the IOW. Christian churches and communities have long traditions of providing shelter, and Night Shelters for those experiencing homelessness have been around for many years. The Shelter is geared towards offering Christian hospitality to homeless people including those who have been living on the streets.*

*This hospitality is more than just tea and sympathy, more than a bed and safe shelter for the night. It also seeks to include a supporting and caring arm to help people to rebuild their lives: so we are making a real difference to people, offering through personal transformation the opportunity to 'move on'.*

*People that need our shelter and support will be accommodated overnight at the IOW Salvation Army Corps from 10pm. However, due to other programmes operating from this provision we are unable to deliver a hot meal/ registration session consistently as would be preferred so we are seeking to develop a rolling church model whereby each church or possibly a few churches open their doors between 7:30 and 9:30pm each night to provide people a safe place to come together; to share a meal and register for the night.*
