If you are new or visiting please make yourself known and feel welcome to join us for breakfast before, and tea and coffee, after the service▲

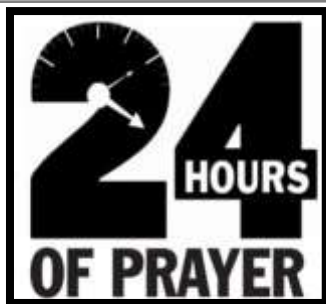

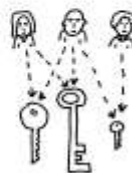

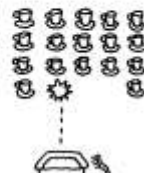
