Church Tithe for 2017 As part of the life of St. Paul's we undertake the Biblical principal of tithing which is giving one tenth of your income to God. Each year 10% of the church income is passed on to others within the Christian community. From our income in 2017 we have been able to help support the following with a donation of £560 each: Christian Friends of Israel (CFI), Barnabas Fund, Compassion UK, Wheels For The World, Revive Newport, IOW Youth for Christ, The Church's Ministry among Jewish people, IOW Foodbank, IOW Christians Against Poverty and Samaritan's Purse.
