Buildings Update

We have now received the Diocese Chancellor's Faculty for our heating and lighting application and following the site meeting on Monday with our contractors the following has now been agreed: The work will be in 2 Phases:

FACULTY

- ▲ Phase 1 Heating & lighting in the side aisles and lighting in the apsidal sanctuary.
- ▲ Phase 2 Heating in centre of the church and apsidal sanctuary.
- ▲ 7day 24-hour timer to be fitted to allow automatic switching on & off of the heaters.
- ▲ Potential start date of Monday 16th April with Phase 1 planned to take one week.
- ▲ Replacement of high-level light at the back▲
