As part of our refurbishment programme for the Christian Centre we will, if all goes according to plan, (is it snowing yet?!), be undertaking some external work this coming week.

Firstly, on Tuesday (20th) we hope to commence work on clearing and preparing the front of the centre garden so it can be grassed over. On Wednesday (21st) we hope to have help from the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Community Rehabilitation Company 'Community Payback Team' in clearing the overgrown area adjacent to the parking area.


