## Don't Miss Out on Church

Communications!

The new EU General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) come in to force on 25th May and govern how business and organisations, including churches, handle and protect your personal data.

In order to hold information like your name, address, telephone number, email, church directory entry or subscription to our church emails, your specific consent is now required.

We are also required to prepare and communicate a notice telling you exactly what your personal information may be used for i.e. our "Data Privacy Notice".

If you would like to continue receiving information by email from St. Paul's or would like an entry in our new Church Directory, simply visit the CONSENT FORM page on the church website and enter your details.

Alternatively, fill in one of the Consent Forms available today and return it to Kevin (usually at the Sound Desk at the back of the church). If you have any questions he will be happy to answer them▲

**are very simple...**

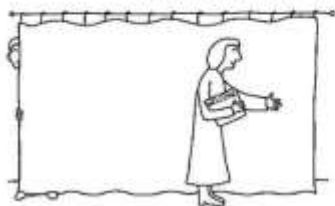

During the time of worship we have an offering (look out for the little brown bag!) We welcome contributions but please don't feel obliged to give!

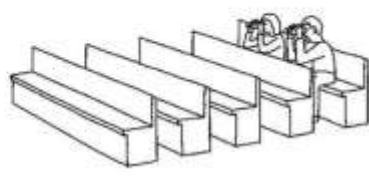
