The PCC met this week with a full agenda covering many areas of 'ministry and maintenance' at St. Paul's! Some of the items agreed were:

- Redecoration of the Christian Centre main hall (to take place in the summer holidays).
- To arrange regular, formalised, housekeeping checks for the Christian Centre. (If you'd like to help with this simple occasional task then please speak to Kevin).
- Action for the PCC to undertake updated training for the safeguarding of children, young people and adults so as to create a protective and supportive environment where all people, especially those who may be vulnerable, are able to worship and pursue their faith journey in safety.
- To proceed with Phase 1 of our heating and lighting proposals (i.e. Additional heating in the North & South Aisles) with a new contractor and slightly different heaters.
- Following our first steps with the 'Thy Kingdom Come' initiative, to continue to pray for our Parish and bring it's residents and their needs before God. There will be another Prayer Walk in the Parish on Friday 29th June - meet at the church at 7:00pm - do come along if you can (or pray at home). If it's raining... you'll get wet!

Bishop Christopher writes: "*Peter and Pippa Sutton will leave the Isle of Wight during the summer as Peter steps back after serving as Archdeacon among us with distinction and commitment. Though we are delighted that Pippa and Peter will continue to play their part in the life of the diocese in the coming years it is right that we mark their service among us while Peter has been Archdeacon of the Isle of Wight.*

Pippa and Peter have contributed significantly to the Island's life, not only in the benefices and parish clusters but also in the wider community, for instance at the Hospice, with Ride and Stride, and in civic engagement. In oversight, pastoral care, and leadership Peter's wisdom, energy and vision have enabled us to move forward as a single Deanery in collaborative ministry, following Jesus Christ and equipping us to be the people of God serving the Gospel and the Kingdom. We shall miss them both very much.
