Coronavirus: latest updates

Covid guidance re removal of Plan B measures

The Plan B Covid restrictions imposed as a result of the spread of the omicron variant were removed on January 27th. The updated national CofE guidance on public worship now applies. Full details can be found at:

The guidance states that face coverings are no longer mandatory in any setting but may be recommended in enclosed or crowded places, particularly where you come into contact with people you don't normally meet.

It is up to individual parishes to decide their own policies with regard to face-coverings, social distancing and ventilation, to keep their congregations and communities as safe as possible.

Dear St. Paul's,

Thank you for your thoughtfulness in giving toward the work of CFI and projects. The start of the year has been surprisingly full.



We have been finalising arrangements for attending the regional Christian Resources Exhibition CRE Exeter early this month where we take the opportunity to reach out to Christians and the wider church to encourage understanding of Israel in the Bible, history and today, through CFI free literature and quarterly magazines alongside the well-stocked CFI UK resources stall.

We continue working closely with the Jewish community regionally and nationally, with the CFI UK / ZF joint Parliamentary briefing and lobby day on Wednesday 9th March 2022 providing a great platform for challenging prejudice and anti-Semitism. Thanking Parliament for proscribing Hamas in its entirety, we now move to request the same for the 'popular front for the liberation of Palestine' PFLP, an umbrella organisation promoting violence and perpetuating mistruths.

Many staff, regional links, church links and supporters have been extensively involved in co-arranging Holocaust memorial events and evenings throughout the country. Following these, giving will be directed to CFI Jerusalem's project 'Forsake Them Not' for Holocaust survivors and also the Christian department at Yad Vashem Holocaust memorial. This month, our trustees meet and will allocate gifts to where most needed in Israel, assisting community there.

Thank you so much for your generosity. It is a great encouragement.

Thank you for your gift to the ministry of Samaritan's Purse.


