

Depending on the government guidelines, we will aim to do all services live online and Bible studies over Zoom.



Ways to Give:

1. **Set up a Standing Order*** from your bank, you can request a form from Penny (our treasurer), or download one from our website. Just fill it in and send it to her or phone for more details or to arrange for your form to be collected.

**A Standing Order is an instruction from you to pay from your bank account to the church. You can cancel it at any time (it is not the same as a Direct Debit and the church cannot take money out of your account).*



A Voice Crying in The Wilderness

In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness in Judea, and saying **"Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven has come near."** **This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah: "A voice of one calling in the wilderness. "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight paths for him. Matt 3:1-3**

John the Baptiser was a special herald of Christ, our Lord. He was literally crying in the wilderness of Judea. At that time there was a spiritual wilderness, confusion, rather like there is today. He was responsible for turning many sinners to righteousness, and a people prepared for the Lord. He

prepared the people for Christ's first coming. As Christians today, we are called to prepare the way for Christ's second coming,

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the Name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I will be with you always, to the very end of the age. Matt 28:18-20

A Spiritual Battle

Ever since creation, the earth has been in a spiritual battle. Everything God created was good, and for His pleasure, but satan, a fallen angel had been cast out of heaven because he got too big for his boots, and disguised as a serpent, persuaded Adam and Eve to eat the forbidden fruit in the garden of Eden from the "tree of the knowledge of good and evil" causing them to disobey God bringing a curse, and separation. on mankind. "I will shake all nations and the desired of all nations shall come, and I will fill the house with the glory," says the Lord Almighty. Haggi 2:7.

We need an "Issacher anointing" to understand the times and the seasons we are living in, and God's strategy for our prayers. Issacher was Jacobs son, one of the twelve tribes, the tribe were men, who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do. 1 Chron 12:32.

Fulfilling the Conditions

God's greatest desire is to pour out His blessing upon His people and the land. However, most promises in the bible contain a condition that we have to fulfil, before that can happen. For example-a well known scripture on prayer.

"If My people who are called by my Name, will humble themselves and pray, and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and forgive their sin, and heal their land." 2 Chron 7:14.

The Condition – humble ourselves, confess, repent, turn around and sin no more. The blessing – God will forgive our sin, and heal our land.

Let them not have dominion over me.

Then I shall be blameless.

And I shall be innocent of great transgression.

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart

Be acceptable in Your sight,

O Lord my strength and my Redeemer. Psalm 19:14

Forgive us Father, where we as a nation, have broken all the ten commandments since 1953. Legalising witchcraft, allowing abortion, killing millions of babies. Permitting homosexuality, even in the church. Allowing same sex marriage. Not keeping Sunday special etc.

We also failed to fulfil our obligation to Israel, for political and financial reasons, with the Balfour and San Remo declarations. Allowing millions to be executed in concentration camps. Those that survived, only to be turned away at Haifa, and then be drowned.

Because He lives, we can face tomorrow, whatever happens. Hallelujah.

He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, And the light that dwells with Him....

For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His Kingdom is from generation to generation, All inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven, And among the inhabitants of earth. No one can restrain His hand, Or say to Him, "What have You done? Daniel 2: 20-22, 4: 34-35.

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore my beloved brethren, we are steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that our labour is not in vain in the Lord. 1 Cor 15; 57-58.

While our prayers may not be answered immediately, we know the effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man or woman radically changes the world around us!

Charles Spurgeon once said, "We cannot all argue, but we can all pray; we cannot all be leaders, but we can all be pleaders; we cannot all be mighty in rhetoric, but we can all be prevalent in prayer."

So let's commit to spending more time in prayer today! Make sure you don't allow the enemy to rob your time to pray -- for it's in prayer that we tap into God's unlimited power that makes demons tremble!
